

Appendix A- Vocabulary for Website

1. Racism

Racism is the marginalization and/or oppression of a person or people based on the color of their skin, or membership in a particular racial or ethnic group.

2. Discrimination

The unjust or prejudicial treatment of different categories of people or things, especially on the grounds of race, age, or sex.

3. Humility- a modest or low view of one's own importance; humbleness.

4. Diversity

The condition of having or being composed of different elements, variety, especially the inclusion of different types of people (as people of different races or cultures) in a group or organization.

5. Inequity

Lack of fairness or justice. If two people commit the same crime and one gets convicted and the other doesn't because he can afford to hire a better lawyer, this is an example of inequity.

6. Empathy

The ability to understand and share the feelings of another.
